Apprenticeships are open to anyone over 18. Job descriptions are created detailing what the apprenticeship will entail and are posted. People apply for the apprenticeship just like any other position.

Apprentices will be paid full-time wage and benefits in addition to going to school. They will work 30 hours a week and receive 10 hours a week for school.

Depending on the apprentice and business need, apprentices may complete an associate's degree, bachelor's degree, or master's degree.
